



MACRA & the Quality Payment Program

- Medicare Access & CHIP Reauthorization Act of 2015 (MACRA)
 - Ends Sustainable Growth Rate (SGR) formula
 - Ends existing Medicare Quality reporting programs
- Quality Payment Program (QPP)
 - Fee-for-value payment system replacing fee-for-service
 - Consists of two tracks:
 - Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS)
 - Advanced Alternative Payment Models (Advanced APMs)

MIPS Eligibility & Exemptions

Medicare Part B MIPS Eligible Clinicians

Doctors of Medicine (MD)

Doctors of Optometry

Doctors of Osteopathy (DO) Chiropractors

Doctors of Dental Surgery/Dental Medicine (DMD/DDS) Physician Assistants (PA)

Doctors of Podiatry

Nurse Practitioners (NP)

Clinical Nurse Specialists Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists

Exemptions

Newly enrolled in Medicare

Enrolled in Medicare for the first time during the performance period (exempt until the following performance year).

Below the low-volume threshold

Medicare Part B allowed charges less than or equal to \$30,000 a year OR see 100 or fewer Medicare Part B patients a year. Significantly participating in an Advanced APM

MIPS Participation in 2017

- Pick your pace for participation
- Practice Fusion supports all levels of participation

Participate in an Advanced APM



Some practices may have chosen to participate in an Advanced Alternative Payment Model in 2017.

Submit a minimum amount of 2017 data (for example 1 quality measure or 1 improvement activity) and avoid a downward payment adjustment.

Partial Year

Submit 90 days of 2017 data and you may earn a neutral or positive payment adjustment.

Full Year

Submit a full year of 2017 data and you may earn a positive payment adjustment.

MIPS: Test Pace Participation for 2017

- Submit a minimum amount of 2017 data to Medicare
- No downward payment adjustment



MIPS: Partial Year Participation for 2017

- Submit 90 days of 2017 data to Medicare
- Potential to earn a positive payment adjustment
- Submit performance data between January 1, 2018 and March 31, 2018



Start your performance period any time between January 1st and October 2nd



MIPS: Full Year Participation for 2017

- Submit a full year of 2017 data to Medicare
- Start your reporting period on January 1, 2017
- Potential to earn a positive payment adjustment
- Submit performance data between January 1, 2018 and March 31, 2018




Positive adjustments are based on **overall performance** on the data submitted, not the **amount** of information or **length of time submitted**.



MIPS Performance Categories



Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS)



The Cost performance category (not pictured) will not be counted in MIPS scoring for the 2017 Transition Year, but will be added in MIPS scoring beginning in the 2018 performance year. This category replaces the Physician Value-Based Modifier program.

Quality

60% of MIPS final score



Quality Performance Category

- Replaces PQRS and the Quality Portion of the Value Modifier
- Select and report up to 6 quality measures*
 - Include at least one outcome measure OR high-priority measure
- Submit data for a Partial Year (90 days) or Full Year



^{*}Test pace participants have the option of selecting 1 quality measure

Advancing Care Information Performance Category

Replaces the Medicare EHR Incentive Program (Meaningful Use)

 - Additional Performance Measures
- Submit data for a Partial Year (90 days) or Full Year



^{*}Test pace participants must report data for all four of the Base Score measures to earn credit for this category.

ACI Base Score Measures

- Required Base Score measures (50% of ACI category score)
 - Security Risk Analysis
 - e-Prescribing
 - Provide Patient Access
 - Health Information Exchange


ACI Performance Score Measures

- Additional Performance Score Measures (up to 90% of ACI category score):
 - ✓ Provide Patient Access (up to 20%)
 - ✓ View, Download or Transmit (up to 10%)
 - ✓ Health Information Exchange (up to 20%)
 - ✓ Secure Messaging (up to 10%)
 - ✓ Medication Reconciliation (up to 10%)
 - ✓ Patient-Specific Education (up to 10%)
 - ✓ Immunization Registry Reporting (0 or 10% yes/no measure)
- Bonus credit (up to 15% of ACI category score)
 - Report to one or more additional public health and clinical data registries beyond the Immunization Registry Reporting measure (5% bonus).
 - Use certified EHR technology (CEHRT) to complete certain improvement activities in the Improvement Activities performance category (10% bonus).

ACI Category Scoring Methodology (continued)



The overall ACI score will be made up of the base score, additional performance score, and optional bonus score for a maximum score of 100 percentage points.

- Submit data for a Partial Year (90 days) or Full Year

Improvement Activities Category Scoring

- Select one of the following combinations for a maximum 40-point score:
 - 2 high-weighted activities
 - 1 high-weighted and 2 medium-weighted activities
 - At least 4 medium-weighted activities

Advanced Alternative Payment Models Overview



Advanced Alternative Payment Models (APMs)

- An APM is a payment approach that gives incentives for providing high-quality and cost-efficient care.
- A sub-set of APMs, Advanced APMs let practices earn incentives for taking on risk related to patient outcomes.
- Path for providers who go the furthest in delivering coordinated and efficient care.
- Applications for the 2017 performance year have closed.



- Comprehensive Care for Joint Replacement (CJR) Payment Model (Track 1 - CEHRT)

In 2015, the Medicare Access and CHIP Reauthorization Act (MACRA) was signed into law. MACRA replaces the product Medicare reinfoursement schedule to a new pay-tor-performance program that's focused on quality and accountability. This program is the latest in a scries of steps the Centers for Medicare and Medicard Services (CMS) has taken to intentivize care quality over volume.

Starting on January 1, 2017, it's proposed that all Necileare Part B providers" will enter a new payment framework called the Quality Payment Program (QPP), replacing the Sustainable Growth Rate formula.


The Program has two paths for participation:

- Advanced Alternative Payment Models (APMs)







- Yes. Practice Fusion is currently certified as a 2014 Edition EHR, which can be used to participate in MIPS and Advanced APMs in 2017.

+ What are the participation options for MIPS in 2017?

- Test pace: avoid a downward payment adjustment
- Partial Year (90 days): potential to earn a neutral or positive payment adjustment
- Full Year: potential to earn a positive payment adjustment
- Meet participation requirements as part of an Advanced APM

+ When do I start participating in MIPS in 2017?

- Test Participation and Partial Year (90-day) Participation have the flexibility to start as late as October 2, 2017
- Full Year: January 1, 2017

- + What are the performance categories for MIPS in the 2017 reporting year?
- + **Quality** Select up to 6 quality measures, including at least one outcome or high-priority measure.
- + **ACI** Track performance on 4 required base score measures, with optional additional performance score measures and bonus points.
- + <u>Improvement Activities</u> Select weighted activities by relevance to your practice, with a maximum available category score of 40 points.
